JENKINS, BEAL BREAK RECORDS

Omaha Poor Second; S.D.S. Third.

BROOKINGS, S. D. (A)—Iowa Teachers' Panthers ran away with the nineteenth annual North Central track and field competition here Saturday afternoon, piling up 72½ points to far outdistance the other six loop rivals.

Omaha university snatched second place with 29 points. The host school, South Dakota State, fol-

lowed with 241/2 points.

Two records went by the boards in the Panthers' defense of the title. One went to the Panthers in the two mile event when lanky Bill Jenkins breezed the distance in 9:59.6, smothering the oldest record on the books. The two mile time of 10:01.2 had stood since Cram of South Dakota State set it 16 years ago.

Beal, Omaha university's flash, chalked up the other new mark in the 220-yard dash. Beal was clocked at 21.7 seconds, clipping one-tenth of a second from the 21.8 time established by Pierce of

North Dakota U. in 1932.

In collecting their high total, the Iowa Teachers placed in all but two events, the javelin and pole vault, and gained eight first places. North Dakota State came in for fourth position with 16 counters and was trailed by North Dakota university and South Dakota university, each with nine, while Morningside tailended with 7 points.
