South Dakota State's Jacks retained their North Central track and field title with a fancy display of balanced strength under a bright blue sky but buffeted by a strong and gusty wind here Saturday afternoon.

South Dakota State scored in all but one event, the 880-yard run, as it rolled to a 56-point total.

Second place Iowa Teachers had 48.

South Dakota U. was third with 30½ points as the other four teams in the conference brought up the rear with a mild scattering of points. Augustana had 7, North Dakota State 6½, Morningside 5 and North Dakota U. 1.

No Records

No record-breaking performances were put forth for the rather surprisingly large (for track) crowd estimated at 700 which sat in the sun at Augustana college stadium.

Top job of the day in that direction was the 12 feet, 6 inches of pole vaulting turned in by Iowa Teachers' Bill Weiler. Weiler broke the crossbar but not the record of 13 feet by Roland White, Teachers '36, after he had eliminated his current competition.

South Dakota State scored five firsts with South Dakota U. and the Panthers getting four each. Dave Eithreim, Augustana, was the only other representative to break into the charmed circle of the lead trio of schools as he topped the low stocks in the No. 1 spot.

Wide Margin

Emil Hurt's wide margin in the two mile for the Teachers 1, 2, 3 punch and 10 of the 11 points awarded for that event drew applause from the crowd. His time was 10:29.3, topnotch considering that he had to buck the capricious wind.

South Dakota State started to widen their mile-relay margin early and left no doubt about the outcome of that feature event. The time was 3:30.9 as against the record of 3:27.4 held by the SDU four of 1922.

Only double winner was Don Coutts, Coyote sprinter, who took the two short dashes.
