

Cedar Falls, Iowa, May 19—(A)—
Iowa State Teachers college won the North Central conference track championship at Cedar Falls, Iowa, today in a heated three-way fight with South Dakota State and South Dakota university.

The Iowa Teachers scored a total of 68 points to win the team title, South Dakota State was right behind with 67½ points and South Dakota university finished a close third with 61 points.

The meet was strictly a three-way contest. North Dakota university in fourth place was far behind with 11½ points.

Plooster Scores

Augustana, with Dale Plooster gaining a second-place tie in the pole vault, ranked next at 4½ points. Morningside, the only other entrant, was last with three points.

Iowa Teachers won 7 first places and South Dakota 6. South Dakota State won only two firsts, but had depth enough to crowd ahead of SDU for second place.

One conference record was broken and one tied, both by Iowa Teachers.

Leland Crew, former state high school half-mile champion from Fairfield, ran the 880 in 1:58.8 to better the old mark of 1:59. That standard was set in 1931 by Ralph Pearson of North Dakota, and matched last year by Don Lange, Iowa Teachers.

Lange ran the 440 in 49.5 seconds to equal the record.

Trophy Reclaimed

The championship trophy was first awarded to South Dakota State because due to an error, the official scorer at first had SDS winning over the Teachers by a half point.

It was fully a half-hour after the meet that a missing point was found and awarded to Iowa Teachers. The trophy then had to be reclaimed from South Dakota State team in the dressing room and given to the Tutors.
