
Five varsity records fell during the competition, and another went in the freshman 880 relay.

LARRY HOFELDT of USD accounted for the first record of the day when he repeated as shot put champion with a throw of 52-1. That replaces the 51-51/4 posted in 1956 by Leroy Dunn of ISTC.

Nyal Brings, SDU distance runner, cracked the mile record in the day's first track event. He went the distance in 4:15.5, eclipsing the 4:18.5 established by Frank McBride of SDSC in 1952.

Herb Lucken of South Dakota State, one of two double winners, scampered over the high hurdles



in :14.9, beating the :15.0 mark posted by Weert Engleman of State in 1930 and tied by Guy Rhoades of State in 1958.

Oddvar Helgeson of NDAC cracked the two-mile mark of 9:40.0, established in 1952 by McBride, outdistancing the field in 9:35.6.

The expected duel between Helgeson and Brings in the twomile failed to develop when the SDU mile winner suffered a leg injury. He finished last in the two-mile field after winning the mile impressively.

THE ISTC mile relay team of Ted Broberg, John Raffensperger, George Soperland and Hal Byram, posted a record 3:23.1 for that event, supplanting the 3:24 established in 1956 by UND.

George Gross, who won both dash events and placed third in the 440 and ran one leg on the second-place SDU mile relay team, carried off individual scoring honors with 14 points.
