

**SIoux CITY** — South Dakota's rampaging Coyotes won the North Central Conference track championship with amazing ease here Saturday.

Dan Lennon's Redshirts rolled up 73 points to 55½ for runner-up South Dakota State.

State College of Iowa finished third at 51½ trailed by North Dakota State 29, Morningside 20, North Dakota 18 and Augustana eight.

The only double winner was Brian MacLaren of NDS. The Bison bomb captured the 880-yard run in meet record time of 1:53.6 and took the 440 in :48.9.

The old 880 mark of 1:54.3 was established by Tom Neuberger of SDS' Jackrabbits in 1952.

SCI's Ron Gerard lowered the high hurdles record to :14.8, Herb Lucken of Madison and the Jacks had done :14.9 in 1960.

Deane Bjerke of SDS, last year's 880 king who was dethroned by MacLaren, smashed the mile standard by running 4:14.

Previous best in an NCC mile was 4:17.5 by Nyal Brings of South Dakota in '60.

SCI freshmen set marks of :43.3 in the 440 relay and 1:29.6 in the 880.

SCI freshmen set marks of ed when Bill Rauhauser, the Panthers' defending broad jump and triple jump champion, missed the meet because of a knee injury which will require surgery soon.

Morningside sprinter Dan Travaille was another potential champion sidelined by an injury.

South Dakota also won NCC cinder crowns a year ago, in 1963 and '61. SCI was champ in between, in '62 and '64. Before that, SDS won three consecutive titles.

Coyote champions included the 440-yard relay team, John Huth in the 440 hurdles (a new event), Ray Dunsmore in the 100, the mile relay team, shot putter Ryan Schmelz and triple jumper Jerry Danburg.

SDS champions included Bjerke, Jay Dirksen in the three mile (another new event), Larry Stoddard of Humboldt in the long jump, high jumper Larry Kramer and pole vaulter Gary Busch, who upset Lowell Linderman of NDS.

Most of Augustana's points were scored by hurdler Paul Simonson, former Washington High trackman who was second over the high sticks and third at 440 yards.
