

# Mankato, USD teams in lead

VERMILLION (AP) — Dave Levos of North Dakota set a conference record of 58 feet, 11 inches in winning his third straight shot put title Friday in the North Central Conference indoor track meet.

The meet concludes Saturday. South Dakota is the leader in the women's division after two final events, while Mankato has the lead in the men's division after three final events.

North Dakota State is the two-time

defending champion in both the men's and women's divisions.

Lora Schloss of NDSU won her third straight high jump title Friday with a jump of 5-7, and John Bodine of NDSU won his third straight long jump title with a jump of 23-10 $\frac{1}{4}$ .

# NDSU teams win conference titles

VERMILLION (AP) — North Dakota State repeated as men's and women's champions in the North Central Conference Indoor Track Meet Saturday.

The Bison outdistanced South Dakota to win the women's title and had 16 points more than South Dakota State in the men's competition.

Chosen as most valuable performers were Nancy Dietman, of North Dakota State, and Rod DeHaven, of South Dakota State.

Dietman won the 1,000 meters in a record time of 2:57.24. She also took the 1,500 meters in 4:41.42.

DeHaven won three events—the 800, 1500 and 5,000 meters. His time of 1:51.31 in the 800 meters is a conference record.

Sue Patterson of NDSU was named Women's Coach of the Year. Tom Bennick of Northern Colorado won the honor in the men's division.
