Ohio State University won the "Big Six" (Ohio Intercollegiate) track meet in Columbus Friday. When darkness fell all but two of the fifteen events had been finished, and Ohio State led with a total of 53 points. The loss of the two events postponed until to-day, the pole vault and the high jump, would not change her position. Walter Mytinger of this city, is in the high jump.
