

COLUMBUS, O., May 18.—Ohio State University today won the sixteenth annual big six track meet after the exciting experience of having to wait until the last three or four events to see whether Ohio Wesleyan and Oberlin could be staved off. The final score was: Ohio State 45; Ohio Wesleyan 28; Oberlin 27; Miami 24; Cincinnati 15½; Denison 14½; Case 11; Wooster 4; Baldwin Wallace 4, and Akron 3.
