

# Oberlin Second, But Won Many Events at Track Meet

Ohio State won the annual Big Six meet at Columbus Friday in one of the closest contests ever held in Ohio. State finished with 49, Oberlin was a close second with 43. Reserve came third with 39 1-2, Wesleyan, was fourth with a total of 28 and Wooster brought up in the rear with 5 1-2 points to her credit.

A number of Big Six records were smashed. "Muff" Portman of Reserve being the big splurge. The giant weight heaver from Cleveland hurled the sixteen pound shot three feet, eight and one eighth inches farther than the previous record made by Lincoln of Ohio State, and the hammer 125 feet, 8 1-2 inches, two feet better than the mark made by "Rube" Schorey in 1906.

Kimball of State cleared the bar on the pault vault at 10 feet, 11 1-2 inches, shattering the record made by Evans of Reserve by 1 1-2 inches.

Baker, Oberlin's phenomenal distance runner, clipped off 7 1-5 seconds from the former mile record and 17 seconds from the two mile. Baker's running in the mile was one of the features of the meet. He led a large field of mllers and was seventy yards to the good after the first lap.

Metcalf and Cole of Oberlin, both former Elyria boys, did their share toward placing the Congregationaists in second place. Metcalf won the high jump and took second place in both the high and low hurdles. Cole secured third in the hammer throw and fourth in the shot put.

Another point winner, who is well known in this city, was Daniels of Lorain. Daniels won the 440 for Wesleyan running the distance in 50 seconds flat, which equals the Big Six record made by Rothwell of State in 1908.

Sharon of Ohio State covered the 100 yard cinders in 10 seconds flat, equaling the record made by Ted Green of Case in '03.
