

May 30.—Ohio Wesleyan university team today repeated performances of the previous two years by winning the annual Big Six (Ohio conference) track and field meet with a point total of 60 1/2.

Miami was second with 41, and Denison third with 23 1/4. Others finished in the following order: Case, 19 1-4; Oberlin, 16 5-6; Cincinnati, 15 1/4; Akron, 13 1/2; Wooster, 9 1/4; Otterbein, 7 1-3; Hiram, 6 1/4; Western Reserve, 5; Ohio university, 2; Heidelberg, 1; Wittenberg, 1 1/4.
