

# WOOSTER WINS O. CONFERENCE TRACK CROWN

Denison, Champion in 1933  
Disappoints by Finish-  
ing Fourth.

GRANVILLE, May 26.—  
Wooster college's track and field  
team climaxed a mediocre season  
by earning a surprise victory in  
the 32nd annual Big Six champion-  
ship here today. Wooster scored  
47 points.

Oberlin and Mount Union col-  
leges tied for second place, with  
28 points each. Denison university,  
1933 champion and the current  
favorite, was fourth, with 25½  
points.

Denison, after going through  
the season undefeated, made a dis-  
appointing showing. Its athletes  
failed to place in half of the  
events.

Ellsworth Trego of Capital  
furnished the only record-break-  
ing performance of the day when  
he won the broad jump with a  
leap of 23 feet, 4¼ inches. The  
old mark was 22 feet, 11½ inches,  
made 23 years ago by Cooke of  
Ohio State.

McCuskey of Mount Union was  
the leading scorer, making 13  
points. Bacon of Denison scored 10  
points; Lease of Wooster, 8½,  
and Hildner of Wooster, 7.

In addition to the leaders, other  
teams scored as follows: Toledo,  
21½; Muskingum, 17½; Hiram,  
13; Akron, 10; Case, 9; Heidel-  
berg, 8; Bowling Green, 7; Capital,  
6½; Otterbein, 4, Kenyon failed to  
score.

The Big Six meet is the official  
Ohio conference track carnival.
