

Otterbein leads OAC track

BEREA, Ohio (AP) — Jon Divine and Eric Anderson finished first and second in the discus Friday to lead their team, Otterbein, into first place after three events in the Ohio Athletic Conference track and field championships.

Divine hurled the discus 143 feet, 3 inches to win the event, while Anderson took second with a toss of 140-6.

Ted Waite of Denison won the long jump with a leap of 22-7 $\frac{1}{2}$, while Craig Polman of defending champion and favorite Mount Union won the 10,000-meter run in 30 minutes, 53.2 seconds.

Mount Union was second in the team standings heading into Saturday's final 13 events with 24 points, followed by host Baldwin-Wallace with 17, Denison with 10, Ohio Wesleyan 8, Heidelberg and Oberlin 2 each and Ohio Northern 1. Six teams failed to score.
