

Ohio Wesleyan Is OC Track Champ

GRANVILLE — Ohio Wesleyan won its fourth Ohio Conference indoor track championship in the 7-year history of the event by outdistancing defending champion Denison Saturday afternoon.

Wesleyan racked up 55½ points to Denison's 37½. Other scores: Capital 28; Oberlin 21½; Wooster 21½; Akron 13; Muskingum 9; Wittenberg 9; and Hiram 0.

The thinclads broke two records. Wooster's 880-yard relay team set a new indoor conference record of 1:35.6. Don Register, former Akron East High star, ran the first leg.

John Gutkenzht of Wesleyan set a new mile run record. He traveled the distance in 4:35. He also was the individual high scorer of the meet with 10 points, after racking up another first in the two-mile run.
