COOKEVILLE, Tenn., May 20— Murray State won an unprecedented fourth straight Ohio Valley Conference Track championship here Saturday on the strength of its strong middle-distance runners.

The Racers piled up 75 points to easily outdistance the seven-

team conference field.

Middle Tennessee was second with 55 points followed by Tennessee Tech, with 50 and Morehead with 38. Other point totals were: Eastern Kentucky 38, East Tennessee 5 and Western Kentucky 1.

Captain Russ Dawson, who headed Murray's 1-2-3 finish in the 880-yard run, tied for high point honors with Tech's Jim Shaffer with 11½ points each.

Murray won eight first places, a record for the meet and set four new records while tying one.

The Racers set new conference marks in the 880-yard run, 440yard relays, mile relay and pole vault. The Racers tied a conference record in the 40-yard run.

Other events in which the Racers finished with a first were in the shot put and high jump.

The victory gives Coach Bill Furgerson a record of four OVC titles in five years as the Racers' head coach.
