

# Western Wins; 12 Records Fall

MOREHEAD, Ky., May 15 (Special)—Twelve new records were established today as Western annexed the Ohio Valley Conference track title at the Morehead field.

For the first time in the 17-year history of the OVC track meet, Kentucky colleges swept the first four places as Western finished first with 77½ points followed by Murray (66), Eastern (57) and Morehead (21).

Other teams and their scores included: East Tennessee (19); Middle Tennessee (17½) Austin Peay (14); and Tennessee Tech (13).

Top individual performances were turned in the 100-yard dash as each of the first three finishers bettered the old league mark of 9.7. Jim Freeman of Murray finished first with a 9.4 followed by Tom Gray of Morehead (9.5) and Jim Dodey of Murray (9.6).

Austin Peay's Risto Alavaudtunki, a student from Finland, lofted a record javelin throw of 234 feet 10 inches which bettered the old OVC mark by 32 feet 5 inches.

Dan Needy of Murray turned in one of the nation's fastest times in the 880-yard run as he established new conference mark of 1:50.2. Morehead's Tom Gray also set a record with a time of 21.0 in the 220-yard dash.

Henry Wadsworth turned in Western's top performance of the afternoon in the pole vault as he easily cleared the old 14-foot mark with a final leap of 15 feet 6 inches.

Other records were set by James Brown of Western with a distance of 46 feet 4½ inches in the triple jump; Charles Allen of Murray, 37.3 in the intermediate hurdles; Augie Schiler of Murray 6 feet 10 inches in the high jump; Jerry Betts of Morehead, 14.1 in the high hurdles; and Bob Grose of Murray, 47.9 in the 440-dash.

The Eastern mile relay team claimed a new standard with a 3:12.1 for the event and Western took the 440 relay with a record time of 47.9.
