

MURFREESBORO — Middle Tennessee State University claimed the Ohio Valley Conference Indoor Track Championship yesterday on the strength of six first place finishes.

The Blue Raider squad barely edged runnerup Western Kentucky for the title. MTSU had 127 $\frac{1}{3}$ team points to 122 for the Hilltoppers.

Murray State was third with 116 points.

Three more conference records fell yesterday, in addition to a long jump record set Friday. John Do Doo set a new triple jump mark with 52 feet, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches, for MTSU. Other records were set by Western Kentucky's Larry Cuzzort in the two-mile run (8:38.7) and MTSU's J.T. Musgrove in the 600-yard run (1:10.3).
