GOLDEN, Colo. — The University of Nebraska at Kearney men's track team won its fourth straight Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Indoor Track and Field Champonship Friday and Saturday in Golden, Colo.

Unlike last year when the Lopers had to win the meet in the last event, the 4x400 relay, the Lopers won easily, outscoring runner-up Adams State by 48 points.

In the women's division, UNK finished second to Western State, with senior Janet Boettcher setting two meet records.

The UNK men's win was the first time a school has won four straight RMAC Indoor Championships. The Lopers also set a team record for the most points scored (144), breaking the record of 143 set by UNK when it won its first championship in 1998.

Four Loper men won individual events - senior Wes Hinze in the 55-meter high hurdles, senior Brett Wetton in the weight throw. freshman Clark Spanel in the long jump and freshman Mike Ford in the pole vault. Wetton's throw of 63-11 broke the meet record. Ford was named the See

LINK also had four second-place inishers - Ryan Bedlan in the 200. cott Schepers in the weight throw and shot put, Derek Bailey in the high jump and John Laux in the triple jump. Laux's effort of 48-4 1/2 is a provisional national qualifying iump

the weight throw and 48-5 in the shot put were meet records. He weight throw breaks her own school record.

UNK's Jana Marco broke the meet record and the school record when she won the pole vault with a mark of 11-0.
