C. U. WINS; RECORDS ARE BOWLED OVER

BOULDER, May 19. — The University of Colorado won the Rocky Mountain track and field meet here this afternoon. The men from Boulder rolled up 38 points. Utah Aggies finished second with 35. University of Utah was third with 32. Points made by the other contestants were: Montana State College, 27 1-2; Colorado College, 16 1-2; Brigham Young, 10 1-2; University of Denver, 10; Colorado Aggies, 5; Colorado School of Mines 1 1-2; University of Wyoming 0.

Four conference records were smashed. Leslie Platt of the University of Denver cracked the discus tossing mark with a throw of 139 feet, 2 1-2 inches, more than the record set up in 1914 by J. Lyman Bingham. Webster of Utah Aggies after a tie for the first place in the pole vault with Powers of Montana State, later in the try for a record, swept 12 feet 1 1-2 inches over the bar and broke the 1920 record of Sewell of the Colorado Aggies.

A new record in javelin was established when Crandall of the University of Colorado hurled the spear 163 feet 5 3-4 inches. The previous conference mark was 160 feet 10 1-2 inches recorded last year.

The conference record for the broad jump was also broken by Watkins of University of Utah, who stretched the distance to 22 feet 7 1-2 inches, just a quarter of an inch more than the record which had stood since 1909.
