

# BOB THOMPSON WINS MILE AND 2-MILE RUNS FOR BOBCATS TO RULE MOUNTAIN'S CONFERENCE

COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo., May 30.—Montana State College captured the Rocky Mountain conference track and field title today, scoring 48 points to 44½ for its closest rival, Greeley State. Colorado College finished third with 37 points and Colorado Mines fourth with 35½.

The only new record established was the low hurdle mark of 26.3 seconds, set by Steve Carson of Greeley State. The old record of 27.4 was hung up by Rehwoldt, also of Greeley State, in 1938.

## Five Firsts for Bobcats.

Montana State garnered five firsts, five seconds and four thirds.

In the junior college-freshmen meet run off with the R. M. C. events, Greeley State's freshmen scored 44 points, Colorado college freshmen 39½, Mesa Junior college of Grand Junction 36, Trinidad Junior college 25, and Colorado Mines freshmen 9½.

The junior collegians and yearlings broke 11 records and most of their marks were better than those recorded in the varsity division.

A phalanx of four varsity runners were inches apart at the tape, split of Montana State was awarded first for the 100-yard dash. Frank Strong place after considerable discussion among the judges. Lloyd Madden, Mines, was given second; Worth Stimits, CCC, third, and Ed Powers, Greeley, fourth.

Bob Thompson of Montana State plucked medals for his chest in both the mile and two-mile runs—a total of three hard-fought miles for the afternoon.
