

Emporia Wraps Up RMAC

Emporia State captured four first places Saturday to sweep the second annual RMAC Track Meet at Jackson Field.

The Hornets racked up 142 points to outdistance Fort Hays' 68. Adams State had 83 points and the University of Northern Colorado Bears totaled 77.

Winning for Emporia were Ted Polts in the 100-yard dash with a time of 9.9, Al Feuerbach in the shot put with a toss of 90 feet, nine and three fourths inches, Chester Bluett in the intermediate hurdles with a time of 54.0 and John Wilson in the triple jump with a leap of 46 feet, eight inches.

One of the Emporia wins, the shot put, set a new RMAC banner and two others either tied or set new Jackson Field records.

Feuerbach's toss in the shot shattered the old record held by Bob Kincaid of Adams State in 1964 of 87 feet, nine inches. Bluett's win in the intermediate hurdles tied a Jackson Field mark and Wilson's triple jump distance set a new field record. All-in-all, five RMAC marks were broken Saturday.

Mike Estes of Fort Hays ran the 440-yard dash in 47.4 breaking the old conference record of 4:16.8. Larry Zaragoza of Adams State ran the 800 in 1:51.8 breaking a record of 1:54.0.

The mile relay team of Fort Hays ran the distance in 3:19.9 shattering the old time of 3:19.3 and Garold Endsley of Kansas State College set a conference pole vault record with a vault of 15 feet, two inches.

Charlie Huggins won the only individual title for UNC. He won the 220-yard dash in 22.2 edging Polts of Emporia by 5 of a second. Huggins also set a UNC record in 440 finishing second to Estes. The old record was by Huggins in 1969 and was 48.5.

Larry Heidebrecht set a UNC mark in the 880-yard run with a time of 1:54.5. He placed fifth in that event. The Bear mile relay squad shattered a school record as the team of Steve Wightman, Jeff Hancock, Mick Denzin and Huggins ran the lap in 3:17.0. They broke their own record set earlier this season.

Eight total records were set in the meet. Three were set during Friday's action. Fort Hays was the defending track champion.
