Adams State wins RMAC

ALAMOSA (AP)-Led by three athletes who won two events each. Adams State blew out the rest of the field Saturday to win the Rocky Mountain Athletic Con-

ference track-meet.

Adams State, in winning its fifth RMAC track championship row, compiled 165 points while runnerup University of Southern Colorado had 105. Western State came in third with 92 followed by Western New Mexico with 82½, Southern Utah with 46½, Colorado School of Mines with 36 and Mesa College with 26.

Frank Gross of Adams State, the host school, set conference records in winning the discus with a throw of 178 feet 1½ inches and the shotput with a heave of 57 feet

6 inches.

Teammate Scott McMillen won the 800 meter run with a time of 1 minute, 54.7 seconds and the 1,500 meter run in 3:56.9 while Ivory Joe Hunt won the 100-meter dash in 10.5 seconds and the 200-meter dash in 21.3 seconds. Hunt also anchored the winning 400-meter relay team, which won in 41.5 seconds.

All running events were in metric distances for the first time, therefore all winning times repre-

sent RMAC records.

The only other double winner was Jack Willey of Western New Mexico. He won the long jump with a leap of 23 feet 6 inches and the pole vault with 14 feet 6 inches.
