The Southern Conference meet was held in the Los Angeles Coliseum on April 3. Occidental College won the affair with 68¾ points; Calteck was second with 39 digits; Pomona third with 36½; Southern Branch fourth with 19¾; Redlands

fifth with 10; and LaVerne and Whittier in sixth place with 1 point apiece,

The surprise of the meet as far as Pomona is concerned was the feat of Willard Rew, sturdy quartermiler, who defeated the field in 51.4s. Rew ran a beautiful race, passing the favorites, Bailey of Oxy and Richardson of Southern Branch in the home stretch. "Fritz" Hezmalhalch also starred in winning the hammer throw with a heave of 132 feet $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches.
