

OCCIDENTAL SPIKESTERS TAKE CONFERENCE MEET

CLAREMONT, April 19.—Coach Payton Jordan, one-time S.C. sprint great, made his first year as track coach of Occidental College a complete success here today as the Tiger spikesters added the Southern California College Conference championship to their dual meet* title by scoring 52 23/30 points.

Pomona College was second with 32 2/5 points, followed by Caltech's 27 5/6, Redlands' 27 1/5 and Whittier's 24 4/5.

Record Smashed

One record — the 29-year-old 440-yard mark of 49s., which was set in 1918 by Kilby of Redlands — was smashed by Oxy's hard-running Bill Parker, who revenged an earlier defeat to Caltech's Ken Shauer by blazing the distance in 48.6s. The time also broke Parker's Occidental record of 49s. set against S.C. earlier this year.

Barreling Bill had himself quite a day. He came back in the 220 to win by two yards over

Shauer in a speedy 21.7s. race. Then in the four-man mile relay race Parker took the baton 10 yards behind Pomona's Francisco Sabichi and finished 10 yards in front. Jordan, in an unofficial clocking, caught the red-thatched Oxy sophomore in 47.9s.

Price Shines

The day's only other double winner was J. D. Price, Oxy's ace timber topper, who captured the 120 highs in 15.3s. and the lows in 24.4s. A few moments later, still breathing hard from his little barrier effort, Price ran in the third spot on the victorious four-man mile team, which brought his day's point total to 11 1/4 and a tie with Parker for high honors.

Redlands' Ed Livingood was the victor by 100 yards in the 10m. 31.1s. two-mile after having taken second behind Teammate Leonard Weed in a 4m. 36.5s. mile earlier in the afternoon.

mark was registered by tiny Mike Coster, who gave the Oxies five more digits with a 190ft. 7in. toss, more than a yard ahead of Whittier's Hal Turley, who notched a 187ft. 3in. effort.

Bob Teagle of Pomona nipped Don Tillman, the favored Caltech performer, with a 46ft. 9 $\frac{3}{8}$ in. toss. Tillman's best heave was 46ft. 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ in.

Orcut Jenness, the top Sagehen sprinter, was two yards ahead of Poet Fred Barton in a 10s.-flat century which was a slight surprise.
