SHIVERS TOPS MARK AS OXY WINS EASILY

Coach Payton Jordan's Occidental College track and field squad more than matched the combined point efforts of all its foes in scoring an easy Southern California Conference championship victory yesterday at Oxy.

The Tigers, held under a tight leash by Jordan, who kept his principal stars in only a single event apiece, scored 90½ points. Redlands had 34¾, Pomona 17, Caltech 11 and Whittier 10¾.

Six Vaults

Dick Shivers, Oxy junior from Arcadia whose best mark before this year was 13ft. 2in., pole-vaulted 14ft. 1¾in. to shatter both the conference meet and individual records held by Jack Rand of San Diego State.

Shivers took only six vaults all afternoon, clearing his record height on the second try just before the rains came to halt any further activity.

Bob McMillen and Doug Martin of Oxy also cracked conference meet marks.

McMillen, the distance star who ran only the 880 yesterday, did 1m. 54.7s. and was trailed by teammate Hal Butler by only five feet. Butler was clocked in 1m. 54.9s.

Skips Furlong

Martin's discus heave of 142ft. 4½in. eclipsed a meet record held by John Raitt of Redlands, more famous in recent years as a light opera and concert baritone.

Oxy's Walt McKibben took the 100 in 9.8s. but skipped the furlong.

The most exciting race of the day went to Oxy's Ted Ruprecht who made up eight yards on

Roger Reinke of Pomona and nicked him at the tape in a 49.5s. 440.

The relay was run in a drenching rain, Oxy splashed to victory in 3m. 21.4s.
