Oxy Runs Away With SCIC Title, Discus Record Set

Occidental's ferocious Tigers swallowed up all their foes in one big gulp in winning their eighth straight Southern California Conference track meet with 93 points last night on Oxy's Patterson Field.

Just as expected, Whittier's Drake Relays-bound Poets placed second with 37½ points. Caltech was third with 13, Redlands fourth with 12 and Pomona-Claremont last with 9½.

Until late in the evening it appeared that the only record happening would be the absence of new meet records. Then Redlands' Rudy Valadez came through with a 143ft. 9¼in. in the discus, which exceeded the standard of 143ft. 1¼in. set last year by Oxy's Doug Martin.

Another Win

Valadez also wound up as the only double winner of the night by taking the shot at 46ft. 1¼in.

Favorites mopped up in specialties but performances failed to live up to the record breaking possibilities. Whittier's Russ Bonham won the mile in 4:18.4 but ran a slow first half and had to hustle home in 60 seconds flat on the last lap to get under 4:20. Oxy's Brayton Norton took the javelin at 180ft.

10¼in., almost 17 feet under his best.

Other Oxy athletes, however, turned in unexpectedly fine performances.

Fast Half

In the half mile Don Munroe headed Whittier's Bruce Weed in 1:56, overhauling the Poet ace turning into the stretch and expanding his victory margin to four yards. Oxy's Ev Trader was clocked in 1:58.4 while placing fourth.

Then Tiger Claude Fiddler turned in the nation's fourth fastest time in the two mile this season with a 9:32.7 triumph. Fiddler lapped two rivals and left second-place Sammy Waltmire of Whittier far down the track.

Tiger Dick Clarke sizzled over the low hurdles in 24.1, leaving the rest of the field several yards behind.

Speedy Relay

The Oxy quarter mile quartet of Rel Schmitt, Trader, Norton and Jon Speer completed mopping up operations by the Tigers, winning the relay in the good time of 3:19.9.
