# Terrill Wins 4:09.9 Mile as Oxy Easily Takes Crown

Jim Terrill led Occidental to an easy victory in the Southern California Conference track meet last night at Oxy's Patterson Field with the second fastest mile of the American spike season.

Terrill upset Whittier's Russ Bonham in the featured mile run and was timed 4:09.9, a mark bettered by only one American runner this year—Wes Santee.

The mile time produced one of six new meet records as Oxy more than surpassed the combined point total of its four opponents. In scoring their ninth straight conference victory Coach Payton Jordan's Tigers rolled up 129½ points.

Bonham set a swift pace for three laps, timed in 60.5, 2:02.5, and 3:06. Terrill took the lead soon after the start of the fourth lap, held a 2-yard margin going down the back-

stretch, widened it around the last turn and was running away at the finish. Bonham was tied in 4:12.7, but was eased up at the finish.

The time broke the meet record of John Barnes, Oxy's 1952 Olympian. The old mark was 4:16.4.

Oxy's other 1952 Olympic contender, Bob McMillen, also lost his two meet records.

## Weed Sets Mark

Bruce Weed of Whittier shaved a tenth second off McMillen's 1:54.7 880 record as he upset Oxy's Ed Shinn. Weed barely caught Shinn at the tape to win by inches.

Claude Fiddler of Oxy easily won the 2-mile in 9:25.9 to break McMillen's 9:30.2 record in this event. Other meet records fell in the shot-put, 440 and discus.

Bill Carling, Occidental sophomore, was a double sprint winner in 9.8 and 21.8.

Whittier scored a surprise in the mile relay with a victory in 3:22.5 as Bonham ran the third lap. A makeshift Oxy team with only one regular relay man in action finished third.
