THREE MARKS FALL AS OXY TRIUMPHS

Occidental scores its annual victory in the SCIAC varsity track and field championships at Oxy, rolling up 113½ points to 41½ for second-place Pomona-Claremont, last night.

Three meet records fell and one was tied.

Oxy's Kelly Hester tossed the discus 169ft. 1in. for a meet and individual record and the second-best effort in the history of Patterson Field.

Bob Gutowski won the pole vault at 14ft. 8in. and later cleared 15ft. on a sixth and unofficial vault. Phil Conley of Caltech pitched the javelin 221ft. 8in. In each case the winner broke his own meet record. The high hurdle standard of 14.8 was matched by Ken Biggs of Oxy.
