WRAY RUNS 4:05.7; GUTOWSKI—15-5 $\frac{3}{4}$

World Record Holder Bob Gutowski vaulted cleanly over 15ft. 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ in. last night but the lean leaper had to share honors with his Occi-

dental teammate, Larry Wray, who ran a smashing 4:05.7 mile in the Southern California Conference meet on Oxy's Patterson Field.

Gutowski jackknifed over the meet record height on his third try after bending the metal crossbar on his second attempt and coming down heavily on the bar on the first shot.

Gutowski never came close to making 15ft. 9in. in three attempts at a new world record. He started at 13ft. 6in. and cleared it on his first jump as he later did at 14ft., then 14ft. 6in. and then 15ft.

Wray, who has more or less played second fiddle to Teammate Ty Hadley this season, recorded the second fastest collegiate mile of the outdoor season and the only native Americans who have run the distance faster are Wes Santee, Fred Dwyer and Bobby Seaman.

Wray, who pushed Seaman to a 4:05.6 mile earlier in the

season, set the pace for two and one-half laps. He turned the quarter in 59 and the half in 2:01.5.

Hadley went to the front on the backstretch of the third lap but Wray regained the lead as the final lap started. Wray beat off Hadley's challenge on the backstretch and won by a solid 10 yards.

Coach Chuck Coker's supercharged Occidental athletes won all but one first place, set six SCIAC records and tied a seventh in rolling up 142½ points. Redlands was second with 33, Pomona-C Claremont third with 31, Caltech fourth with 11½ and Whittier last with 7.
