

Cinder stars wearing the Green and Orange of Florida A. and M. College combined their talents to wrap up the conference crown at the 16th annual SIAC Track and Field Championships, Saturday afternoon, at Atlanta University Athletic Field. Cloudless skies and a balmy spring breeze provided ideal weather for the thrill-packed 15-event program.

First place honors were well distributed but the well-balanced Rattler squad carried off top laurels in four events and scored in seven other events to sweep the title with 47 points.

#### **CLARK PANTHERS WIN SECOND PLACE**

The Clark College Panthers made a strong bid for the coveted crown but had to be content with runner-up honors with 27 points. Tuskegee Institute was third with 17 points and Allen University finished in fourth place with 16 points.

The Xavier University Gold Rush spikesters, defending champions, rolled up 13.5 points. Total points of other colleges in the loop were distributed as follows: South Carolina State College, 11.5; Bethune-Cookman College, 9; Alabama State College, 8; Morris Brown College, 8; Fort Valley State College, 4; and Morehouse College, 4.

#### **GREENE, CANNON, BROWN SCORE DOUBLE VICTORIES**

Sharing the individual spotlight with double victories were Robert Greene, of Allen; John Cannon and Frank Brown, of Florida. Greene Allen senior, from Ft. Myers, Fla., streaked home in 9.6 in the century and was clocked at 21.1 in the 220 yards run. Cannon, Clark's sensational hurdler from New Orleans won both hurdle events in good time; and Brown broke the tape first in the 440 yards run and won the running broad jump.

Other individual winners included: Lee Brown (Tuskegee) 880 yards run; Blanton Owens (Alabama State) one mile run; Bennie Thomas (Florida) two mile run; Steve Daniels (Morris Brown) javelin throw; Bennie Mann Allen) discus throw; Roman Turman (Clark) shot put; and John Arnold (Florida) pole vault.

The Bethune-Cookman College Wildcats brought the baton home first in the classic one mile relay. The gifted quarter was composed of: Jasper Harrell, Wallace Raspberry, Charles McNail, and James Pittman.

Tuskegee scored a smashing victory in the 880 yards run when Lee Powell, Charles Bonner and Arthur Dunn finished one-two-three. John Cannon and Arthur Johnson, of Clark, finished one-two in the hurdles.
