

DURHAM, N. C., May 16—(AP)—Duke University's track and field stars scored in 13 of the 15 events of the Southern Conference's fourteenth annual outdoor carnival today to give the Blue Devils the championship with a total score of 67 1-3 points.

Only one record was officially bettered today, but one made in the trials yesterday took its place in the books.

North Carolina's Tar Heels, defending the championship, came second, with 34 1-2 points. Other scores were: Virginia, 31 2-3; Clemson, 22 1-2; V. P. I., 20 1-2; Maryland, 18 1-2; V. M. I., 18; N. C. State, 7, and Washington and Lee, 5.

Discus: First, Zori of N. C. State, 152 feet 2¾ inches; second Shockey of Virginia, 135 feet 4¾ inches; third, S. W. McConnell of Clemson, 133 feet 5 inches; fourth, Williams of Duke, 129 feet 2¼ inches; fifth, Fielder of Virginia Military, 127 feet 4¾ inches. (New record, old record, Zori, 151 feet 7 inches in 1934.)
