440-yard run: Won by Ragon, Washington and Lee; second, Jennings, North Carolina; third, Johnson, Duke; fourth, A. Miller, Maryland; fifth, Ochsenreiter, Maryland. Time, 48.9 seconds.

100-yard dash: Won by Murphy, Maryland; second, Little, South Carolina; third, Reavis, Duke; fourth, Holmes, North Carolina; fifth, Curl, Washington and Lee. Time, 9.8 seconds. (Tied record, held by five men, first set in 1925 by Foster, of V. M. I.)

Shotput: Won by Strickler, V. M. I., 48 feet 8½ inches; second, Craig, South Carolina, 48 feet 7⅝ inches; third, Nania, Duke, 44 feet 8½ inches; fourth, Echols, V. M. I., 44 feet ½ inch; fifth, Slagle, North Carolina, 43 feet 1¼ inches. (New record. Craig's distance set new mark yesterday. Strickler had previous record at 48 feet 4¼ inches, 1938).
