

WILLIAMSBURG—The University of North Carolina won the Southern Conference track championship for the third consecutive year yesterday in a close 65-57 finish with the iron-man Maryland squad.

Duke finishing one-two in the discus, first and a tie for second in the shot put, and first in the javelin, won third honors with 41 5-6 points.

Six other point-winning squads trailed far behind, William and Mary getting 14 1-2, which included a tie for top place in the pole vault; Washington and Lee, 13 1-3; Richmond, 11 1-3; South Carolina, 8; North Carolina State, 7, and V. M. I., 7.
