

DAVIDSON, N. C., May 10—

(AP)—A record jump by Bob Storm carried the William and Mary Indians from behind Saturday to their second straight Southern Conference track championship.

The margin was  $3\frac{1}{2}$  points over The Citadel, surprising runnerup,  $47\frac{1}{2}$  to 44.

Another unexpected high finisher was Furman, whose 31 points gained third place.

West Virginia was fourth with 29, and Virginia Tech was fifth with  $28\frac{1}{2}$ .

Other finishers were VMI 18 points, Davidson 16, Richmond 9, Washington and Lee 2.
