

The Citadel wound up its night's work with 59 points to 39 $\frac{5}{6}$ for runner-up Furman and 38 $\frac{5}{6}$ for surprising West Virginia. William and Mary, like the Mountaineers a real surprise package this weekend, took fourth with 33 with Virginia Military Institute fifth with 31. Other schools and their final point totals were Virginia Tech 24 $\frac{1}{3}$, Davidson 12 and Richmond 2.
