

Indians Take

S. C. Track

LEXINGTON, Va. (AP) — William & Mary demolished all comers Saturday night to take its fourth straight championship in the annual Southern Conference Indoor Games.

The powerful Indians, who started fast and left the opposition out in the cold snow, amassed 114 points. East Carolina was second with only 42 points and Furman finished third with 37.

Five records fell during the meet, two of them to William & Mary.

The Indians' Doug Griffith picked up two first-place finishes, in the 60-yard low hurdles and the 60-yard high hurdles, to turn in W&M's top individual effort.

Furman's one-man team turned out to be Kim Piersol, the meet high scorer with 17. He finished first in the triple jump, second in the high jump and 60-yard dash and third in the long jump.

In the triple jump, Piersol broke his his own year-old meet record of 48 feet 10 inches with a 48-11 effort.

The William & Mary relay team, composed of Dave Watson, Mike Fratkin, Vince Norako and Bill Findler, beat their old meet record of 3:24.2 with a clocking of 3:23.9.

Howell Michael of W&M broke the first meet record as he took the mile run in 4:07.9, bettering the 4:12.4 mark set by Terry Donnelly of William & Mary in 1958.

Richmond's Carl Wood sped to a 1:11.8 victory in the 600-yard run, slightly off his meet record 1:11.6 registered in trials.

Paige Davis of East Carolina chopped down a twice-tied record in the 440-yard run, finishing in 50.3 seconds. The old mark was 51.8.
