VMI Edges ETSU Buccaneers

JOHNSON CITY, Tenn. - A word sometimes overused in sports these days is class, but that is just what Coach Dave Walker showed after his East Tennessee State Buccaneers lost a close battle to Virginia Military Institute for the Southern Conference track championship.

"Therell be another day," said Walker, after VMI won the last event of the day, the mile relay, to take a 173-167 win over second-place ETSU.

Walker watched the Buccaneer relay team take third in the race from the stands, then he walked out on the track, congradulated the winning coach and started checking to

make sure the wrapup on the meet went smoothly.

"Actually, it went better than I thought it would for us," Walker explained after the meet. "We got some points from our sprinters I dion't anticipate but I undersold our team, like I have a tendency to do."

The two-day indoor track and field meet, held here at the Buc-Dome, saw four new Southern Conference records set and another tied.

VMI passed the league mark of 3:20.9 in the mile relay, the event that gave them the championship, with a time of 3:14.91. Eugene Scott had a 51 feet, three inch jump to surpas the old record of 51-01/2 and Appalachian State's Jordan Laffette ran a 47.69 440 for a new record, beating VMI's Dennis VMI - 39-101; Watts 1978 mark of 49.7.

Mark Scruton of ETSU set a new conference record in the 880 preliminaries Friday night, running a 1:11.66, and although he didn't do as well in the finals Saturday, he did win the race with a 1:52.25 mark. The old record, set in 1972 by James Kidd of East Carolina, was 1:53 2
