Palomar Places Second in JC Track Meeting

VISTA (Special) — El Centro's 26-man track team scampers away with the South Central JC Conference track meet at Vista Saturday by edging Palomar Junior college, its nearest rival, 83½ to 67½. Of the other teams competing in the windup of the track and field season, Citrus, with 58½ came in third, Oceanside-Carlsbad JC with 8½ was fourth, and Antelope Valley gathered five points for last place.

The showing of the Palomar team "was better than expected," said Comet Coaches Hueston Harper and Kenneth Williamson. Ray Lee Farris, by placing second in the hundred as well as in the 220, bettered his season's marks for both races. Lee Anderson jumped as high as his own head to take a tie for first in the high jump. Anderson again jumped over his head and tied with Bobb Hitt of Palomar and

two El Centro men for a first in the pole vault.

Stanley Maag flung the javelin 15 feet farther than he had ever thrown before to win an impressive victory in that event. Dick Smith did a quick shift from his baseball uniform to pick up a couple of points in the low hurdles. George Ross outdid himself to place in the broad jump and high hurdles. Dodwin, a new boy at Palomar, also picked up a couple of points in the highs.
