

# CENTRAL RETAINS SPIKE TITLE; CITRUS SECOND

AZUSA, May 5—Central Junior College of El Centro successfully defended its All-South Central Conference track and field championship today, defeating four other teams with a total of 89 points. Citrus JC was second with 81½.
