

Vaqueros Capture SCC Track Crown

Santa Barbara City College recaptured the South Central Conference track championship at La Playa Stadium yesterday, winning eight of 14 events, setting one school record and tying another in the process.

The Vaqueros picked up 58½ points to unseat defending champion Antelope Valley in the league meet. Palomar placed second and Antelope Valley was third. Imperial Valley and Oceanside trailed.

RECORD NULLIFIED

Phil Minah of City College was the "rough luck" contestant of the day, setting a new school record in the first event of the afternoon, the mile run, only to be disqualified for crossing in front of Art Serrano of Palomar, who was awarded the victory.

In an earlier meet, Serrano had beaten Minah and the Vaquero distance star had trained for the league meet to reverse the decision. He beat Serrano in the time of 4:35.2, but the time was wiped out when officials disqualified Minah for the infraction.

The event goes into the books with no time.

WILDER STARS

Individual star of the meet was Vaquero Bob Wilder, who won four events and ran a leg on the winning mile relay team, to personally account for 21¼ of the total Vaquero points.

Bill McArthur, Gene Vernon and Jim Larsen were the other Santa Barbara winners.

Wilder's 24.8 time in the 220-yard low hurdles tied the school record, and the 3:31.7 clocking by the Vaqueros mile relay team of Minah, Ed Jacobson, Vernon and Wilder broke the old school relay mark of 3:33.5, set in 1958.

This marked the third time since the SCC championships were started in 1957 that Santa Barbara had won the title.

Palomar won three events, Antelope Valley took two, and Imperial Valley one. Oceanside failed to win an event.
