

# Antelope Valley Loop Track King

Antelope Valley unseated Santa Barbara City College here yesterday as champion of the South Central Conference track division, piling up 60½ points in a wind-heavy meet at La Playa Stadium.

Palomar College placed second in the meet with 54 points, and defending champion Santa Barbara came in third with 44½, with Imperial Valley and Oceanside rounding out the parade.

Two records were set in the meet, in which Santa Barbara took five first places, but lack of depth kept Russ Wenzlau's troops from piling up a greater margin.

Ken Simmons, Vaquero distance star, took the half mile, mile and two-mile runs; Nito Saucedo won the pole vault, and Hugh Taufasau took the long jump, for the

first wins for the defending champs.

The five first place finishes were high for the meet, with no other school hitting that mark. Palomar had four wins to help annex second place in the SCC competition.

Simmons took the half mile in 2:06.6; won the mile in a slow 4:41.8, with no pressure, and ran away with the two-mile in 10:11.6, which gave added stature to the City College student as one of the top distance men on the coast.

Saucedo cleared the bar at an even 12 feet to win the pole vault for the locals, and Taufasau had a winning 22 ft. 5 in., to take the long jump.

Simmons, who collected 15 points for his three victories, was named outstanding athlete of the meet, while Taufasau had a big day with his win in the long jump and third place finishes in the pole vault, high jump and triple jump.

There were some 60 competitors in the meet, and records were established in the triple jump and 330-yard intermediate hurdles, both new events.
