Maton runs to double victory

CHARLESTON — Jim Maton stragically went to the bleachers soon after the Mid-Continent Conference track meet ended.

He knew after Eastern's coaches were thrown into the steeplechase water in the championship celebration tradition his teammates would be looking for the star of the meet next.

- Maton avoided getting wet just as he made the right moves on the track for a double win Saturday.

The Panthers' all-American saved some energy by coasting to the 1,500-meter run victory and then four races later passed the leader on the final turn to take the 800.

It meant a successful finale at O'Brien Stadium for Maton whose team won the Mid-Continent Conference outdoor meet three of his four years at EIU.

This marked Eastern's biggest margin as it scored 140 points to runnerup Northern Iowa's 92.7. Western Illinois has 49.8, Southwest Missouri State 41 and Cleveland State 10.5.

Maton repeated as a double winner with slower times than he ran last year. By only running a 3:55:55 in the 1,500 — last year he did it in 3:50.58 — he wasn't worn out before facing Northern Iowa standout Jeff Burris, who ran only the 800.

Burris led until the final turn of the 800 before Maton passed him and finished in 1:49.59 to beat Burris' 1:50.78.

It wasn't the type of race Maton would run against top national or world competition. Then he sets a fast pace hoping to wear down those who have more leg speed. Saturday Maton figured he was the fastest.

Two other Panthers were double winners — roomates Jeff Gennarelli and Mike Geisler.

Gennarelli added Saturday's hammer championship to Friday's shot put win and also placed a surprising second in the discus with a personal best 151-61/2.

Geisler won the javelin Saturday with a meet and school record 204-½ distance after setting conference, school and stadium marks Friday with 7,116 points in the decathion Friday.
