

# UNI sets four records to win track crown

CEDAR FALLS, IA. — Wayne Simon and Brooks Glasnapp each had a pair of victories and Northern Iowa set four Association of Mid-Continent Universities indoor track records Sunday in winning its third straight title in the UNI-Dome.

Simon won both the long jump and the triple jump while Glasnapp set a new record in the 600-yard dash with a 1-minute 11.95-second clocking and ran one leg of the mile relay in which UNI's quartet was clocked in record time.

Other Panthers setting records were Todd Goodell in the two-mile run and freshman Jeff Burris in the 880-yard run. Goodell won his event for the second straight year.

UNI Coach Chris Bucknam was named Coach of the Year for the second consecutive year.
