

Eastern ends UNI's AMCU track reign

CHARLESTON, Ill. — Host Eastern Illinois won six events and ended Northern Iowa's three-year hold on the AMCU-8 men's indoor track championship here Saturday afternoon.

The Blue Panthers totaled 91 points to 75 for the Purple Panthers of UNI.

Ten conference records were shattered along the way Saturday, including two by Northern Iowa.

Panther Jeff Burris set a new record in the 880 with a time of 1:52.02 and the UNI mile relay team of Brad Bartelt, Jim Turner, Burris and Brooks Glasnapp ran a 3:16.12

for another new standard.

UNI also finished 1-2-3 in the two-mile with Dan Hostager hitting the finish line ahead of teammates Tom Penningroth and Trent Timson.

Eastern's Jim Maton was named athlete of the year.
