

# Records fall; UNI dominates AMCU

CEDAR FALLS (AP) — Northern Iowa's Brad Miller, Tom Penningroth, Kent Terrillion and Dan Hostager each set conference records Saturday as the Panthers dominated the AMCU indoor track and field championships.

The Panthers had 78½ points to finish ahead of runner-up Eastern Illinois, which had 68½ points. Although the conference is comprised of eight teams, only two others competed, with Western Illinois capturing third place with 26 points and Southwest Missouri finishing last with 23 points.

Brad Miller of UNI won the pole vault with a 16-1¼ effort to break the AMCU mark of 16-0 set by a pair of former UNI runners, Troy Becker (1985) and Ralph Adams (1984).

Penningroth established a record in the 3,000-meter run, finishing in 8 minutes, 19.33 seconds, while Terrillion ran the 800-meter run in 1 minute, 52.46 seconds for his record. Dan Hostager finished the 5,000-yard run in 14 minutes, 39.39 seconds for another record.

Northern Iowa's mile relay team of Terrillion, Brad Bartelt, Jeff Burris and Brooks Glasnapp also set an AMCU record, finishing in 3 minutes, 16.11 seconds.

Meanwhile, Fred Neal of East-

ern Illinois won the 600-yard run in 1 minute, 10.32 seconds for a conference record and teammate Gregg Heggs won the 200-meter dash in 21.8 seconds for another record.

The Eastern Illinois two-mile relay team of Al Oaks, Steve Conlon, Neal and Jim Maton set an AMCU mark with a time of 7:34.54.

Maton also was named the conference's athlete of the year for the third straight year, and Chris Bucknam of Northern Iowa was named coach of the year for the third time in the last four years.

In other events, Western Illinois' Chris Chapman won the 55-meter dash in 6.47 seconds, another conference mark, while teammates Arnold Johnson and Ulysses Dantzler also established AMCU records. Johnson won the 55-meter high hurdles in 7.64 seconds and Dantzler won the 400-meter dash in 48.19 seconds.
