UNI men finish second at **Mid-Continent track meet**

CHARLESTON, Ill. - Despite winning seven events, the University of Northern Iowa had to settle for second place in the eighth annual Mid-Continent Conference indoor track meet held here Friday and Saturday.

Eastern Illinois won the meet with 63 points while UNI had 57. Western

Illinois was third with 47.

"It was an outstanding meet," said Panther coach Chris Bucknam, "It was close all the way. We won more events than anybody else, but Eastern

Illinois had more depth."

Eastern's Braidy Miller, a junior weightman, was voted the meet's Athlete of the Year. He set a conference, Lantz Fieldhouse and Eastern school record winning the 35 lb. weight in 67-0 3/4 feet and also placed first in the shotput in 57-9.

For UNI. Bill Castle was first in both the mile run (4:12.45) and 3,000 meter (8:22.95). He was also third in the 5,000 and earned more points than any other contestant in the meet.

The mile featured one of the best* races of the day as the top three finishers were within one second of each other. Following Castle was Jim Fagan (Eastern) just two hundredths of a second behind the winner. In third was Ron Faganm (Eastern) with a time of 4:12.85.

Kenny Shedd was also a double winner for UNI as he won both the 400 and 200 dash. In the 200, Shedd topped Lantz Fieldhouse mark. In the pole vault, Brad Miller not only set a school mark of 17-5 1/4, but also topped the NCAA provisional qualifying mark.

Also setting a new meet mark was Junior Chukukere in the triple jump (51-23/4)
