

Hornet Trackmen Win Dixie Title

The Lynchburg College track team captured the Dixie Conference track championship for the fourth straight year yesterday at St. Andrews on a strong performance by an 11-man squad.

Coach Jerry Shelton's boys, who scored nine first places, had 81 points while UNC-Charlotte had 68 and St. Andrews was third with 31.

The Hornets set Dixie records in three events and tied another despite being handicapped by a steady rain in Laurinburg, N.C. Hugh Lezeur's pole vault mark of 12 ft. 6½ inches broke the old mark and the Hornets 440 relay team (Jack Forvour, Frank Murray, Jack Toms, and Eddie Driskill) set a new mark with a 44.3.

Driskill tied his own conference mark with a 10 seconds performance in the 100 yard dash and broke the old mark of 22.7 in the 220 by posting a 22.4

Carl Pellini, a freshman from Forest Heights, Maryland, was the top point man for LC with 16. Hugh Leazer and Driskill followed with 12 and 10 points respectively.
