

LAURINBURG, N. C. — (Special to Daily Press) — Christopher Newport College set three records and won four first places in the Dixie Conference track meet Saturday at St. Andrews College.

Dirl Riddle of CNC set records in the mile run (4:28.4), the 880 (1:59.0), with John Clark a record-setter in the 440 intermediate hurdles (56.0) and the Captains' mile relay team putting a new mark in the books with a 3:28.0 timing on the running

of Gary Jackson, Bill Robbins, Riddle and Clark. The old mile relay record was 3:31.5 set by Lynchburg College in 1967.

The Hornets won the Dixie meet with 108 points, followed by CNC with 77, St. Andrews with 58 and Methodist with 27.

In the mile run, the Captains placed 1-2-3 and fifth, with Ed Elmore second, Fran Mastaler third and Bill Alto fifth.
