

**LAURINBURG, N.C.** — Christopher Newport College won 15 of the 18 events and set four conference records as the Captains rolled to their sixth consecutive Dixie Conference Track and Field championship Saturday at St. Andrews College.

Only three teams participated in the meet, which was run in a cold, wind-driven rain. The Captains compiled 120 points, while second-place St. Andrews registered 42. North Carolina Methodist College was third with 23 points.

CNC sprinter John Clark was named the meet's Most Valuable Performer and coach Vince Brown was selected as DIAC Coach of the Year for the fourth straight season.

Clark took firsts in the 100- and 200-meter sprints, setting conference records of 10.78 and 22.3, respectively. CNC swept both events, with the top four finishers breaking the meet record in the 100 and the top three in the 200.
