Zaugg had trailed Westen in the heptathlon until the javelin event. Her 112-foot, 10-inch toss, which was 9 feet better than Westen's throw, enabled her to erase a 35-point deficit and emerge 29 points ahead.

Zaugg went on to finish second in the last event, the 800-meter run, earning 756 points. Her point total of 5,208 was 100 more than Westen's final tally. Westen could do no better than fourth in the 800.

In third place was New Mexico's Heidi Anderson, with 4,956 points, followed by teammate Kritian Martin with 4,754, Misty Galvez of Utah State at 5,238 and Missy Hanlen of Colorado State at 3,319.
