Moorpark College women second, men third at WSC meet

BAKERSFIELD — The Moorpark College women's track team placed second and the men took third at Wednesday's Western State Conference Track and Field Championships at Bakersfield College.

Santa Monica College breezed to the women's title with 172 points. Moorpark finished with 81 and Bakersfield was third with 64.

Glendale won the men's competition with a score of 143. Bakersfield was second with 127 and Moorpark finished with 89 points.

The top six finishers in each of Tuesday's events earned berths in the Southern California Community College Track and Field preliminaries, scheduled for Tuesday at Bakersfield College.

Rhonda Ribar was the top Moorpark qualifier,

advancing to the Southern California prelims in four events. She placed second in the 1,500 meter run (4 minutes, 59.2 seconds) behind Santa Monica's Midge Arteaga (4:55.6). She also anchored the 1,600 relay team that placed second (4:15.4) behind Santa Monica (4:14.2). Other members of that team were Irene Lewis, Kim Erickson and Sue Wolf.

Ribar placed third in the 800 (2:26.0) and fourth in the 3,000 (11:13.0). Teammate Christina Rogers placed fourth in the 1,000 (11:13.1).

Erickson qualified in the 400 with a fourth-place time of 64.7. Jeanelle Hawley advanced in the high jump, placing third on a windy day. Her height was 5-0.

Kathy Scott placed sixth in the triple jump with a leap of 33-6 $\frac{1}{4}$. De Carroll won the javelin

competition with a toss of 121 feet, 10 inches.

The 400 relay team of Lewis, Wolf, Scott and Erickson qualified with a third-place finish in 52.4.

According to Moorpark coach Manny Trevino, the Moorpark women were forced to compete without two of their top athletes. Lisa Ash suffered a mild contusion in her leg and Renee Hembree, who has already qualified for the state championships in the heptathlon, twisted her ankle during Tuesday's competition.

Mike Holcomb qualified in three events for Moorpark. He placed third in the 400 at 49.5 and competed on both relays. On the 400 relay he teamed with Russ Blackstone, Brent Moors and Glenn Wellman for a third-place finish in 42.7. On the 1,600 he teamed with Wellman, Gary Gorian

and Juengling for a third-place finish in 3:21.3.

Paul Juengling of Moorpark qualified in two events for the men. He placed sixth in the 110 high hurdles in 16.2 and in the 400 intermediate hurdles (56.0).

Paul Myers placed first in the 3,000 steeplechase with a time of 9:44.8.

Moorpark qualified two athletes in the discus. Ed Maulhardt placed first with a toss of 148-11 and Ken Lowther took second at 144-11.

They also qualified two in the shot put. Donnie Laut won the event with a 54-1 $\frac{3}{4}$ toss and Lowther placed third at 51-6 $\frac{1}{2}$.

Other Moorpark qualifiers were Chris Pressman in the 1,500 (4:06.3), Shane Kilgore in the triple jump (44-0), Chris Ludwig in the long jump (22-8 $\frac{1}{4}$), and Bo Poling in the javelin (197).
